

## Regional Level Workshops on Right to Water and Sanitation

As part of the ongoing project on 'Preparing for Campaign around Right to Water and Sanitation', a joint project of the Forum for Policy Dialogue on Water Conflicts in India (Forum to be brief) and WaterAid India, a series of regional level workshops has been taking place. The objective of this workshop is to share the position papers on Right to Water and Right to sanitation, develop a consensus around these issues and at the same time form a string network to initiate this campaign forward. During the past one year, four regional level workshops have been organised, covering geographically important locations. These are:

- Southern Regions of Karnataka, Tamil Nadu, Andhra Pradesh and Telangana.
- Western regions of Maharashtra, Gujarat and Rajasthan
- Hilly and mountainous regions of Uttarakhand and Himachal Pradesh
- Flood prone areas of Bihar, Jharkhand, Uttar Pradesh, Odisha and Jammu Kashmir.

All these workshops were unique in the sense the issues pertaining to water and sanitation were quite different and possessed different challenges and solutions. All the suggestions and inputs from these workshops are helping to develop the content on the approach paper on Right to Water and Right to Sanitation.
