

Mahanadi stakeholder meeting, February 2015

The Forum has initiated a four year project in the Mahanadi basin to study three different themes. These themes are, a) Agricultural and Industrial Allocation and Use, b) Environmental flows within river basins and c) Competition and conflicts around groundwater. The project is currently in second year. The activities outlined under each theme include analysis of secondary data, conducting field visits and presenting the findings under various outputs. The ongoing research is based on participatory approach and therefore stakeholder meetings are conducted to gather data and information and present the research in a nuanced manner. The second stakeholder meeting (which included participants from the states of Chhattisgarh and Odisha) was conducted in Bhubaneswar on the 27th February, 2015. About 40 people from both the states attended the meeting.
