

**State level and regional workshops on right to water and sanitation:**

The Forum for Policy Dialogue on Water Conflicts in India and WaterAid have been organising a series of workshops. In this year, 4 workshops have been conducted so far. One of these was a state level workshop, covering the State of Uttar Pradesh. The other three were regional workshops covering the North-East states, Southern region of Karnataka, Andhra Pradesh, Telangana and Tamil Nadu and the Western region, covering the states of Maharashtra, Gujarat and Rajasthan. The main objective of these workshops have been to build up a larger consensus around the Right to Water and Sanitation Campaign and build up the content for these rights. At each of these workshops, the draft approach papers on Right to Water and Right to Sanitation have been discussed and the results have been an enriching and participative discussion, where regional specific experiences around domestic water and sanitation were also discussed.
